



Middle School Book Rental/Purchase

**Please see that
all of your student's
belongings are labeled!**

Rental books will be picked up in the classroom on the first day of school. If these books are lost during the school year or not turned in at the end of the year, parents' accounts will be charged for the cost of a replacement.

All other books are to be purchased online through MBS Direct (www.mbsdirect.net) or by calling 1-800-325-3252. MBS has the books that your child needs to order listed by grade. Please order in time for your child to have their books on the first day of school.

Please note- Lost books (other than rentals) will be replaced online by parents.

School Supplies

The following items are basic supplies which all Middle Schoolers should have. Please make plans to purchase these by the end of the first week of school. Additional supplies will be recommended by classroom teachers once school begins.

1. A large, sturdy, 3-ring binder (1-1/2 inches or more). Zipper closure encouraged. **Or 3** separate binders color coded for blocked subjects (Math/Science; English/Social Studies and Foreign Language/Music/Art/Computer)
2. A set of color coded subject dividers for each binder.
3. Five (5) large envelopes or expand-a-files (one for each academic subject). These are to be kept at home. Periodically, teachers will instruct students to remove papers from their binders and to store them in envelopes at home.
4. Pen/pencil case for miscellaneous supplies.
5. A 3-ring hole punch (should be able to clip into binder).
6. Pens, pencils and erasers.

Please remember our Backpack policy: *No book bags or back packs inside the Middle School, during the school day.*
****All book bags must be placed inside a locker.****
